



The University of Akron Women's Soccer Summer Camps, 2010

High School Team Camp, June 28 – July 2

\$75 per player.

Designed specifically for the development of female high school soccer players, this camp provides perfect preparation for the high school season. The camp is planned around a minimum of 9 sessions over four days. A typical camp consisting of eight teams would include a minimum of two segments of 4 x 1.5 hour practice sessions tailored to your technical and tactical needs, and 5 x 60 minutes games against other high school teams. Teams must guarantee a minimum of 12 players for registration. **A non-refundable \$30 deposit is required from each camper before June 12 to guarantee a place in camp. Please use camp registration form to apply.**

Residential Camp, July 3-7

Girls, ages 10 and up. \$450 resident - \$400 commuter.

Designed for female junior high school and high school players who wish to continue playing at the college level, this camp focuses on the individual's ability to play under high pressure and within game conditions. Technical and tactical aspects of the game will be refined in different playing environments from small-sided games up to 11 v 11. Residential campers will be provided with breakfast, lunch, and dinner; commuter campers will be provided with lunch and dinner. **A non-refundable \$50 deposit is required from each camper before June 12 to guarantee a place in camp. Please use camp registration form to apply.**

Team discounts

Team discounts apply to the Residential Camp only; call the soccer office for details.

Staff

The camps will be directed by the University of Akron Women's Soccer Head Coach Chris Pfau, a ten year professional, sixteen year Director and Assistant Director of soccer camps, and head coach of the 2006 Missouri Valley Conference coaching staff of the year. Coach Pfau will be joined on staff by the University of Akron assistant coaches and the women's soccer student-athletes.

Facilities

Both camps will be held at Lee Jackson Field and on the adjacent turf practice field. The state-of-the-art Stile Athletic Field House includes a 100 x 50 turf field and will be used in case of inclement weather. Residential campers will be housed in dorm rooms on campus.

Camp Insurance & Parental Authorization

The camp carries secondary medical insurance. Parents/guardians are expected to provide primary medical insurance for their child. *Each participant must complete an updated parental consent form (Medical Information/Medical Emergency Authorization) on file with the camp each summer.* Please be sure to notify the trainer at check-in if any medical information has changed.
